Construction Update – Work in your area

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney, we are building a new light rail line to provide fast, reliable public transport from Circular Quay, through the CBD, to Kingsford and Randwick via Surry Hills, Moore Park and Kensington.

New traffic arrangements at the following intersections from 20 March 2017

- Arthur Street and Botany Street
- Botany Street and Barker Street

As part of construction of the CBD and South East Light Rail, Ward Civil have completed work at the following intersections:

- Arthur Street and Belmore Road,
- Arthur Street and Botany Street,
- Botany Street and Barker Street.

The work undertaken involved the installation of new traffic lights and pedestrian crossings. This important work will assist both pedestrian safety and traffic flow as light rail construction increases within this area.

New traffic arrangements

Botany Street and Barker Street

- No right turn from Barker Street eastbound into Botany Street.
- No left turn for vehicles over 10m from Barker Street westbound into Botany Street.
- No left turn for vehicles over 10m from Botany Street northbound into Barker Street.



Botany Street and Arthur Street

- No right turn from Botany Street southbound into Arthur Street.
- No right turn from Arthur Street westbound into Botany Street.
